Monument is dominated by a statue of a soldier, Sadao Munemori, standing atop a tall white column flanked by plaques with quotes and dedication. Veterans are dressed in suits and lay flowers on graves. The men are identified (97.267.57\_4) Henry Nakamura, Henry Oyesato, Ken Okamoto, John Ushijima, Akira "Sunshine" Fukunaga, and George Miki.
