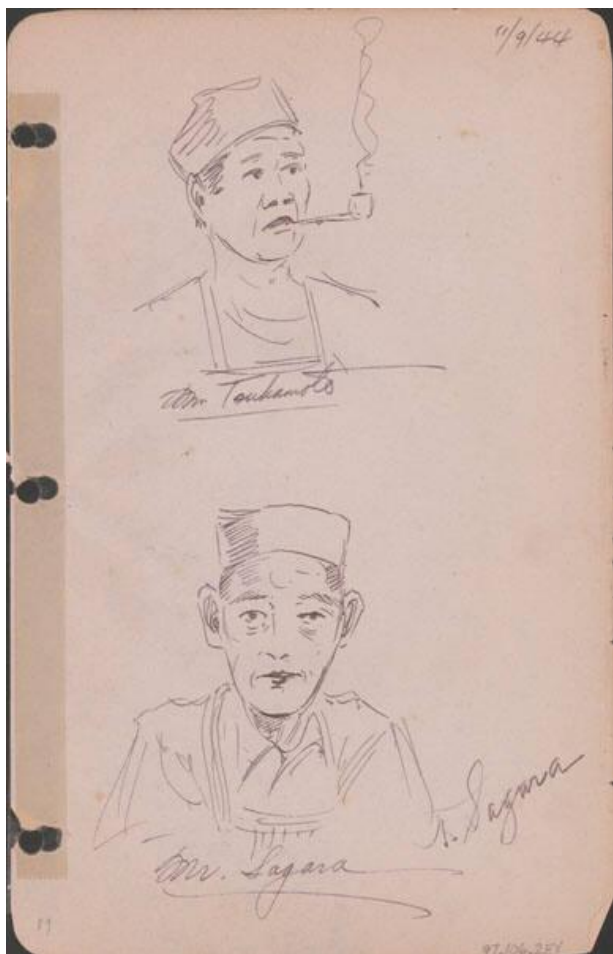

Ink portrait sketches of two men, Mr. Tsukamoto and Mr. Sagara, at Gila River Relocation Center, Rivers, Arizona on November 9, 1944. Top portrait of Mr. Tsukamoto in a brimless cook's hat, smoking a pipe. The straps of an apron are visible over a t-shirt. He looks to the right of viewer. Visible from shoulders up. Bottom portrait of Mr. Sagara in brimless cook's hat and apron over a collared shirt. Sagara has lines under his eyes and looks directly at viewer. Visible from chest up.
