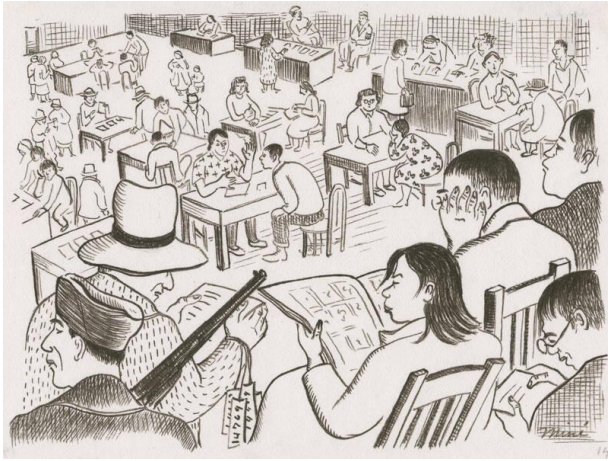

Mine sits on a chair beside four other men in foreground facing the main hall away from viewer. The head and shoulders of a soldier with a rifle is visible at bottom left corner.
