It was good of June & Sandra to remember my birthday. Say thank you to them. Glad to know that you got the telegram at last. Guess we can't help it being late in present times. I've written to let you yesterday as believe will be coming from him soon. We are starting a class on art from tomorrow twice a week and I'm to be the instructor. It will be a very good experience for me and hope it will turn out alright. Will you send me the list of names I've requested in my previous letters? I'll need them as soon as possible if you had not done so yet. Send me also the water color set I have at hand. Also get 2 or 3 bottles of drawing ink and some fine point drawing pen, write for News or Stationer if you can. Also help a dozen drawing tablets. There's also some thick papers. I need for Sunday school picture show. Send about 12 of them. Let me know what you are sending when sending things. Am waiting for the baby. Regards to all. Yours with love, George
