a package of wooden slippers, also message from Mrs. Sato. Hope
you received them. Glad to know that man is helping you.
Please extend my thanks to them, especially to Mr. & Mrs.
Kobayashi. Meet Mrs. Yoshiko Furuyama, 31-4 to, the
son, Mijuteru's daughter. Do glad you met Taka.
We'll see her again when we go back. Everybody is here.
Had dinner yesterday evening. This day today, will
write to Hawaii soon as I can. Do you bid. Keep
healthy & your children hope will be together soon.
