This morning Mr. Hoshida returned from New Mexico and told me that you are healthy and so forth. I was sorry that you didn't get the picture which I sent. It was a color picture and the over home picture, I am sending it back with this letter so I hope you receive it all this time.
I received all the things you have sent to me so do not worry. The warming pad is working alright, and I am making very good use for the children and for myself. Jim and Sandra were very glad when I gave them the candle. They enjoyed it very much. It is very hard to buy these candles here. Sister brought me a box of butterfinger and something else. It is very nice to the children and myself. It wrote to me that he is coming over next month again. I am very proud to have a nephew in the army.
Please do not worry about the children and I, for we are very healthy and doing very fine. I am doing my best to take good care of them so don't worry.
Jim is attending school everyday and studying very hard. He is very good in everything. He seems to me that he is pretty good in writing and drawing, just like daddy. He always draws a pretty picture at school and has a good mark on it. He is very proud now because he can write in long hand. I think she is writing you a letter. You'll be surprised when you receive her letter.
