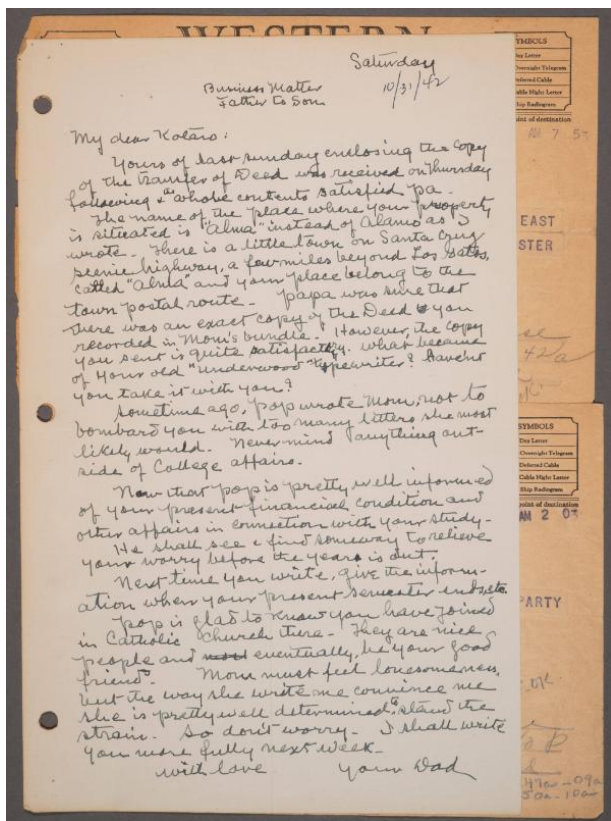

Description

1 letter written on a 3-ring paper to Kotaro from Koh on October 31, 1942. It is titled "Business Matters / Father to son." Koh writes about the transfer of deed and shares that he hopes Kotaro's mother is not sending too many letters. Under the letter is a Western Union telegram on Dec 1, 1942 to Taro Murai with his address listed writes about requesting wire night letter during next semester; Ends with S. Namikawa. Bottom Western Union telegram on Dec 16, 1942 to Taro Murai that writes about attaching three hundred more for Kotaro from the same party; Ends with S. Namikawa. On lower right is a faint stamp that reads, "By: K to be filed". On verso in graphite pencil reads, "Rec'd telegram from Mr. [illegible] concerning THREE HUNDRED STOP THANKS VERY MUCH + MERRY XMAS LETTER FOLLOWING".
